## Learn About ESG & Our Approach

At Vigilshore, we integrate ESG (Environmental, Social, and Governance) principles into our Venture Equity (VE) and Risk Management (RM) operations. Our strategy emphasizes robust G (Governance) and E (Environmental) metrics, utilizing stringent S&S (Sourcing Standards) and P-A (Partnership Audits) to ensure compliance with our internal KPIs (Key Performance Indicators) and external benchmarks (e.g., GRI, SASB, TCFD).

### G-Approach: Ethical Conduct & Corporate Governance (CCG)

Our G-strategy prioritizes EBP (Ethical Business Practices) and T&A (Transparency & Accountability). We mandate rigorous P-A protocols and periodic R&A (Regular Audits & Analyses) to assess partner compliance with our CCG requirements. Through a framework that leverages ESG due diligence (ESG-DD), we ensure that all partners align with our best-in-class governance protocols and ECP (Ethical Conduct Policies).

### E-Approach: Sustainable Sourcing & Renewable Integration (SSRI)

Our E-framework focuses on SS (Sustainable Sourcing) and REI (Renewable Energy Investing). We enforce strict ESG-compliant criteria for our sourcing partners, ensuring minimal environmental impact (MEI) and alignment with global sustainability targets (GST). Our REI initiatives are supported by quantitative metrics (e.g., carbon intensity, CI) and qualitative assessments (QA), providing a dual-layer evaluation that enhances our overall E performance.

### ESG Evaluation & Support Protocol (ESP)

- S&S and P-A: We implement advanced S&S protocols and conduct regular P-A to ensure partners' adherence to our ESG benchmarks.
- R&A: Our R&A processes are designed to monitor and update our ESG KPIs, ensuring continual improvement and alignment with industry standards (e.g., GRI, SASB, TCFD).

- **Advisory Interventions:** In instances where partners exhibit suboptimal ESG performance, we initiate targeted Advisory Interventions (TAI) to facilitate compliance and improvement.

## Transparency & Reporting Mechanism (TRM)

Our TRM comprises quarterly updates (QU) and event-driven disclosures (EDD) that provide stakeholders with a detailed overview of our ESG performance. These reports incorporate both quantitative KPIs and qualitative analyses (QA) to offer a comprehensive view of our ongoing ESG initiatives. Our TRM is integral to our commitment to T&A and serves as a key communication tool with our LPs (Limited Partners) and other external stakeholders.
